THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Entrance Antiphon: Blest be God the Father, and the Only Begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Spirit, for he has shown us his merciful love.

Response to the Psalm: Happy the people the Lord has chosen as his own.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Glory to be the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, the God who is, who was, and who is to come. Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon: Since you are the children of God, God has sent into your hearts the Spirit of his Son, the Spirit who cries out: Abba, Father.

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Entrance Antiphon: He fed them with the finest wheat and satisfied them with honey from the rock.

Response to the Psalm: The cup of salvation I will raise; I will call on the Lord's name.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! I am the living bread which has come down from heaven, says the Lord. Anyone who eats this bread will live for ever. Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon: Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord.

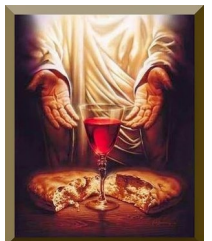
TENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Entrance Antiphon: The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; whom should I dread? When those who do evil draw near, they stumble and fall.

Response to the Psalm: With the Lord there is mercy and fullness of redemption.

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! If anyone loves me he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we shall come to him. Alleluia!

Communion Antiphon: The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my deliverer; my God is my saving strength.
