Ash Wednesday

This begins Lent and is kept this year on 14th February as a Day of Fasting and Abstinence, calling us to enter into Christ's journey to Death and Resurrection.

Fasting: the law of fasting binds those who have attained their "age of majority" (normally 18 years) until the beginning of their 60th year. One is allowed only one full meal during the day, and two "collations" (a snack, such as a slice of toast for example). Coffee, tea or water may be taken as necessary, and those who are unable to fast for serious reasons of health are not bound by the fast. Many over 60 years may continue to fast if they wish to do so. The second day of fasting in Lent is Good Friday.

Abstinence: as determined by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, every Friday of the year (excepting Solemnities and Holy Days of Obligation) obliges those of 14 years not to eat meat in remembrance of the Death of the Lord. Both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence in Lent.

Priests and parents are to ensure that even those who, by reason of their age are not bound by the law of fasting and abstinence, are taught the true meaning of penance, of turning away from sin. Lent is a very good time to do this, especially by example. Although Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation, it is a Day of Devotion, linked closely to the giving of Ashes, reminding us that we are dust, and because of sin will die, in hope of Resurrection.
