# Advent approaches - Time to get ready!

My recent shopping trips in Tadley have given me the impression that Christmas (The Mass of Christ) has already arrived – "Happy Christmas" signs all over the place and other shoppers talking about the things needed for Christmas dinner!

However, before Christmas there is Advent, a time of preparation and reflection enabling Christians to engage in the true meaning of the actual Christmas Season. A time to stop and consider that Jesus, our Saviour and Brother, is becoming one of us, without sin, to die for us, so that whilst rejoicing in His birth we are also looking forward to His Second Coming to bring us into the Resurrection. *Adventus*, the Latin title from which comes the English Advent, is about that which is to come, which is approaching. And the Lord does not arrive for his First Coming until Christmas Day, to prepare us to await the blessed hope of His coming again at the end of time. It is also the beginning of a new Church Year and starts on the weekend of 2nd and 3rd December this year.

One good way of getting ready would be to attend the Forum of Churches Together Around Tadley (CTAT) if you live in that part of the Parish. Learn of the CTAT Toy Collection, of the Tadley Living Nativity on Wednesday the 20th of December at 4:00 PM not to forget the Flight of the Christmas Angels in the preceding days! The Forum is held next Thursday 16th of December 7:00 PM for 7:30 PM, at Saint Mary's Church, just up the road from Saint Michael's Church.
