GREETINGS TO MY NEW PARISH FAMILY

A Eucharistic Community of Love

Dear Friends in Christ,

At the request of Bishop Philip, I have been given the privilege and honour to serve as your pastoral priest-in-charge at Tadley and Burghfield Common. Following in the footsteps of Fr Patrick, who has served you faithfully for the last seventeen years, it is my intention and hope that, with the help of God's grace, I too will serve you faithfully and as best as I am able to.

I will seek to nurture and help you in growing spiritually stronger and closer in your relationship with Christ, our Lord and Saviour. I will strive to fulfil my duties as a priest by encouraging you to greater faith in God, primarily through proclaiming the Good News, since "faith is born of the Word and nourished by it" (Vat II: PO #4).
