Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

“One Body, One Spirit, One Hope” (Ephesians 4:4)



This Sunday is the beginning of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity when all Catholics and Christians around the world are invited to reflect on their shared identity in Christ as *one body with one Spirit and one hope*.

Unity is not presented simply as an ideal, but as a **divine mandate at the heart of our Christian identity**. Pope Leo XIV has echoed this vision in recent ecumenical dialogue, emphasising that the call to unity is rooted in Christ's own prayer: *that they all may be one* (cf. Jn 17:21). Unity among Christians does not mean uniformity but a mutual exchange of spiritual gifts, reflecting the harmonious oneness of life in Christ amidst our rich diversity.

As we enter this week of prayer, let us open our hearts to the Holy Spirit's work in moving us from division to communion, toward the full unity that Christ wills for his Church.
