The Beatitudes – The Path to True Happiness

In this Sunday's gospel we are presented with Matthew's 8 Beatitudes (derived from the Latin words *beati sunt*, "blessed are") The Beatitudes, like the 10 Commandments, are guidelines that help to lead us along the path of God. The path to true happiness. In the Beatitudes, Jesus teaches us something new that is even more deeper and more perfect than the 10 Commandments. That is why he says: ***"Think not that I have come to abolish the law and the prophets; I have come not to abolish them but to fulfill them"*** (Matthew 5:17). The Beatitudes are to do with inner dispositions of the heart.



The Catholic Catechism (#1723) teaches us that each 'beatitude' promised by Christ "confronts us with decisive moral choices. They invite us to purify our hearts of bad instincts and to seek the love of God above all else. They teach us that true happiness is not found in riches or well-being, in human fame or in any human achievement – however beneficial it may be – such as science, technology and art, or indeed in any creature, but in God alone, the source of all good and of all love."
