Hopefully the Church will be open for Sunday if the boiler is working & an update will be sent on this at the end of the week.

My thanks to Christine Caren, who spent considerable time with me today on her appointment as safeguarding officer for Tadley area, and with Dan concerning our parish website, which she and her husband care for.

Dan and I have been addressing the blocked drains around the Tadley property, and appreciate the support of Ben Rowden on this.

The Burghfield Common site needs considerable tidying up which is beyond the ability of the small group of volunteers there, and with Ellen Goodall we are in touch with the Community Payback organisation for this to begin in November.

As from Sunday I shall be having a break and will not be available until 1st November, for the All Saints Day Masses. Remember this is a Holy Day of Obligation and the times are in this update.
